- Digital image makers are encouraged to visit our website (Photochrome.org) to learn exactly how to mark images for competition. Incorrectly marked images may be rejected for competition. There is a size constraint of 1024 pixels on the longest side.
- 4. Any image that has placed (1st, 2nd, 3rd, and HM) in one format must be retired and may not be entered again in any category or different format. (i.e. an image that has placed as a projected image, may not be entered as a print in competition.)
