Each member of Photochrome may enter four images (slide or digital submission) in each of the following categories\*: Pictorial, Nature, Photo Travel, Photo Journalism, and Creative. Awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th places will be given out at the end of the year for each of these competitions. All winning images, and the Image of the Year will be presented in a slide show at the Annual Banquet. Start putting your best in a folder. If you submit the maximum number of images allowed we are talking xx images each. Go for it!

- The Jaques & Margot Segal Award – Best image of a National Park or Monument
- New for 2010: Best Monochromatic image – Best black and white (no duo-tones(+), isolated color or muted color images)
